### The company

Cocoanect BV is a cocoa trading company based in Rotterdam, The Netherlands. Cocoanect is part of COUNT, a multinational company group active in trade, storage, and logistical operations with more than 75 offices worldwide.

### Sustainability

Sustainability is a key pillar of Cocoanect. We source our beans from origins all around the world, and together with smallholder farmers, exporters, and other partners we build dedicated supply chains to improve the daily lives of our farmers. Our projects cover a broad range of topics including biodiversity gender, climate change, and child labour. At the base we ensure that our farmers receive international sustainable training packages of UTZ Certified, Rainforest Alliance, or Fairtrade international, and on top of that we build partnerships with external experts for so-called cert+ activities to increase our impact. We always thrive for innovation and efficiency, with permanent presence in origins and close ties to our farmers. Our program is currently reaching more than 50.000 farmer households, mainly in Ivory Coast, Ghana, Nigeria, and Cameroon. We are expanding activities to East Africa and Lat. ### The Job

Cocoanect is looking for a Program Manager to manage sustainability projects and partnerships in Ghana. The key responsibilities of the candidate are to:

- Manage execution of projects related to environmental conservation & agroforestry with suppliers and external partners like Agro Eco, Rainforest Alliance, GIZ and the Ghanaian government.
- Coordinate sessions for farmer trainings and coaching on agronomy & climate protection (Farm Development Plan, Climate Smart Cocoa, etc)
- Supervise the construction of nurseries for cocoa seedlings and multi-purpose trees, as well as the distribution and shade tree registration.
- Establish and maintain demo-farms to demonstrate Good Agricultural Practices to farmers
- Monitor progress of certification activities of our cocoa suppliers in the field
- Support our M&E digital data collection with field staff from our cocoa suppliers

### The team

You will be working in our dynamic sustainability team that is spread over The Netherlands (Rotterdam) and West Africa (Ivory Coast, Ghana, Nigeria, and Cameroon). In Ghana, you will be working with a small team of 2 program managers and another project officer and in close collaboration the dedicated sustainability teams of our cocoa suppliers. Internationally, you will be in contact with the operational teams of our sustainability department (20+ FTE) as well as our project partners.
